

A Demographic profile of Ward 52 within the Nelson Mandela Bay Area

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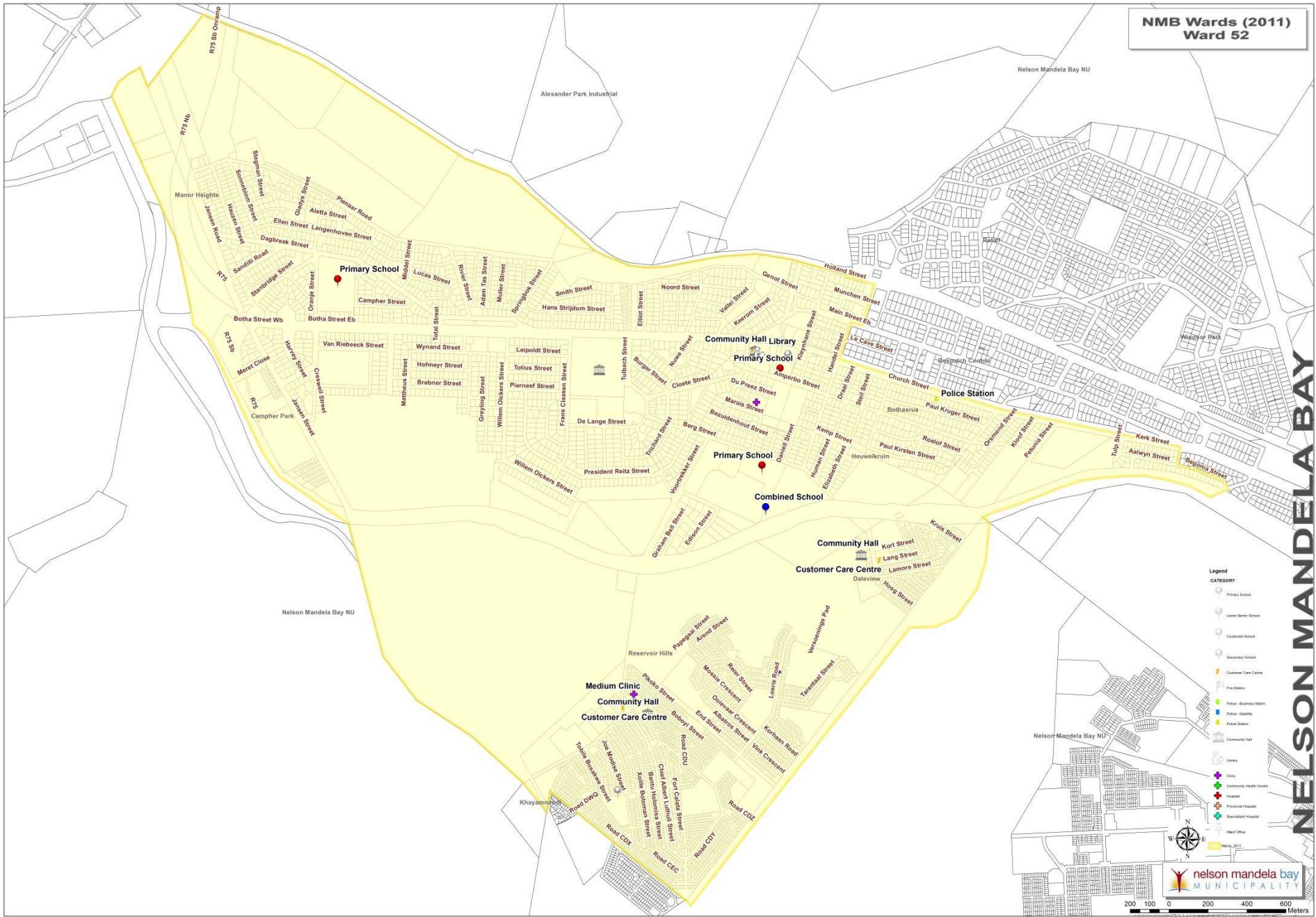

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Abstract:

The information and tables that follow are based upon the Census 2011 information as obtained from Statistics SA (StatsSA).

This information can be used and quoted as the official information for the ward number listed whilst giving credit to StatsSA and the writer. Key results for the ward, in addition to the tables extracted are obtained within the report. The only additions to the tables extracted from StatsSA are the totals rows and columns with percentages. The format was inspired by City of Cape Town Ward reports generated by the Strategic Development Information and GIS Department.



Ward 52: Description

Ward 52 has a geographical area of 10.67km² and the Census 2011 registered this ward as having a total population of 23 581. This ward has a higher female population than male with 48% males and 52% females. A total of 42% are whites, 29% are Black African whilst 28% are Coloured. The main language used in the households is Afrikaans spoken by 68% of the population.

This ward has the following community services:

- 1x Police Station
- 1x Libraries
- 4x Primary Schools
- 1x Combined school
- 2x Secondary School
- 3x Clinics
- 3x Customer Care Centre
- 1x Ward Office (Located in Ward 53)

Key Results for Ward 52:

- The population is predominantly White.
- The population consist largely of females
- 51% of the population are aged between 25 -64
- 40% of the population 20 years of age or older have completed Grade 12 or higher.
- 43% of the working population (15 – 64) is employed.
- 21% are unemployed or discouraged work-seeker.
- 51% of households have a monthly income of R3183 or less.
- 100% of the Households (7041) are located within the urban area.
- 94% Live in formal dwellings
- The average household size consists of 3.35 people.
- 76% of households have access to piped (tap) water inside their dwelling.
- 93% of households have access to a flush toilet connected to the public sewer system.
- 90% of households have their refuse removed at least once a week.
- 87% of households have access to electricity for cooking in their dwelling.
- 94% of households have access to electricity for lighting in their dwelling.
- 59% of households have access to electricity for heating in their dwelling.

Statistics South Africa (StatsSA) defined a household as a group of people who live together, and provide jointly with food and other essentials for living or alternatively, a single person who lives alone.

Please Note: When Statistics South Africa calculated the true population, there were omissions and duplicate counts encountered during the enumeration process which needed to be rectified. This resulted in small variations in the totals for populations and households within the tables located in this report. These variations are not significant however, they will account for the varying totals.
